Balloon Sinus Dilation Procedure



Pre-Op Instructions

Please let Dr. Ashford know if you are on any blood thinners (such as Coumadin), Aspirin products, or antiinflammatory medications (such as Advil, Motrin, Ibuprofen, Aleve, Celebrex, Toradol, Naprosyn, etc).

We will call-in three pills for you to take prior to your procedure. One medication (Valium) is a relaxation medication, one is a pain pill (Norco) and one is a nausea preventative (Phenergan). In addition, please purchase an over-the-counter nasal decongestant (Afrin or Neo-synephine). Because these medications may cause drowsiness, you will need someone to drive you home the day of the procedure.

7 Days Before	STOP ALL ASPIRIN (and products containing ASPIRIN)
5 Days Before	STOP ALL ANTI-INFLAMMATORY MEDICATIONS and VITAMINS
The Morning of the Procedure	No restrictions on eating or drinking. We encourage you to have a light breakfast or lunch prior to beginning preprocedure medication.
90 Minutes Before	Over-the-counter nasal decongestant (Afrin or Neo-synephine), one squirt each nostrilTake one Valium
60 Minutes Before	Over-the-counter nasal decongestant (Afrin or Neosynephine), one squirt each nostril
30 Minutes Before	 Over-the-counter nasal decongestant (Afrin or Neosynephrine), one squirt each nostril Take one Valium
Upon Arrival	Take one Valium, Norco, and Phenergan

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
